



Twitter

Vocabulary

- **Tweet** A 140 character or less message sent from Twitter.
- **@ Mentions** Preceded by the @ symbol; send your Tweet to specific people and everyone you follow. They also can receive an e-mail of your tweet.
- **Re-Tweet (RT)** Passing along good info in someone's Tweet to your network of followers.
- **Direct Message (DM)** – A private message between two people.
- **Hashtag (#)** – Organizes ALL Tweets by topic. A hashtag can be included anywhere in the tweet but typically found at the end. Example: #edchat
Note: You can make your own hashtag if you wish!
- **Follow** To add people to your Twitter feed.
- **Followers** People who see your Tweets
- **The Twitterverse** The world of Twitter
- **Unfollow** Removes a follower from your feed
- **Block** To deny access of a person to your Tweets
- **Protect your Tweets** To restrict viewing of your tweets to your followers only
